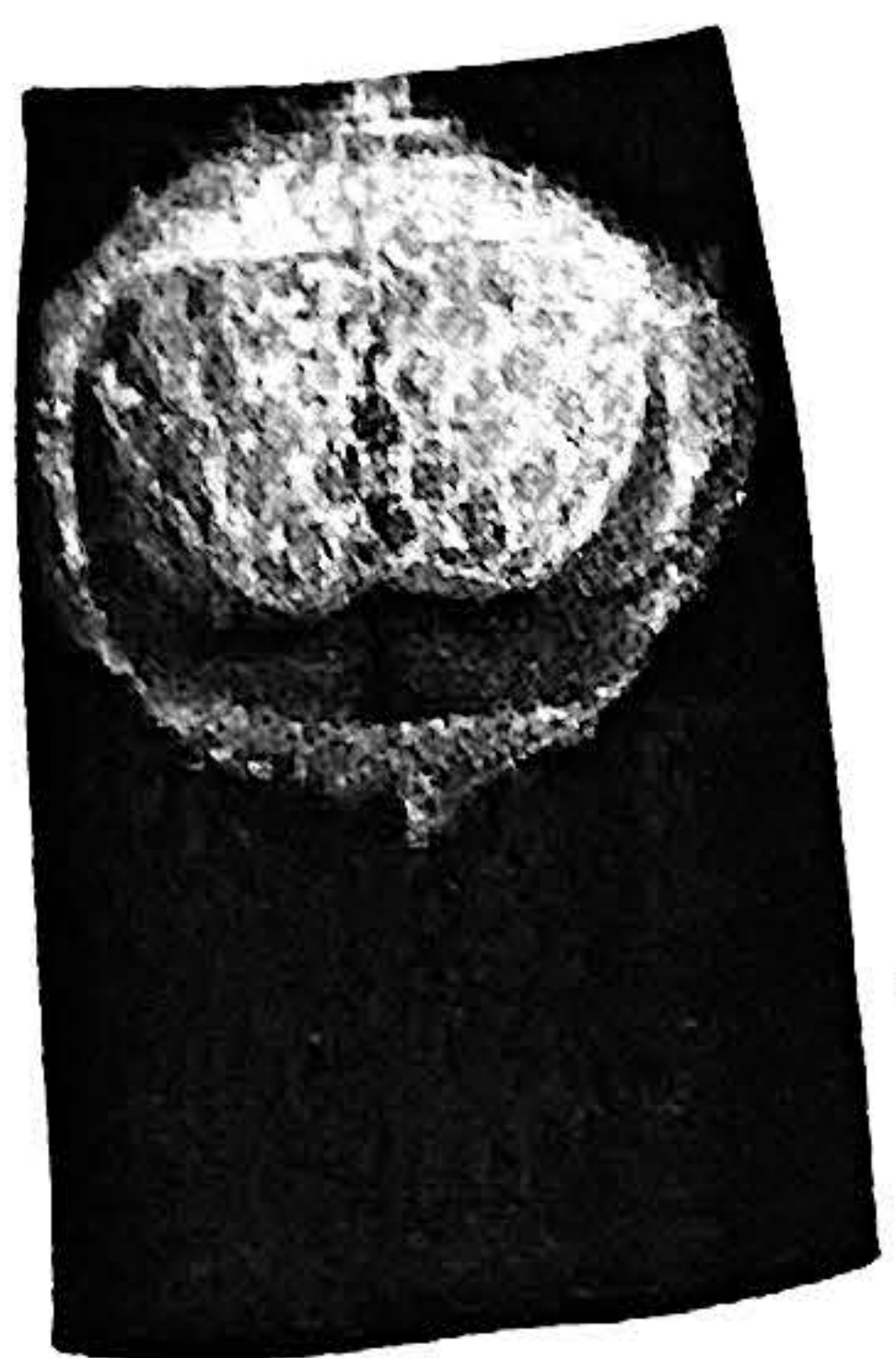
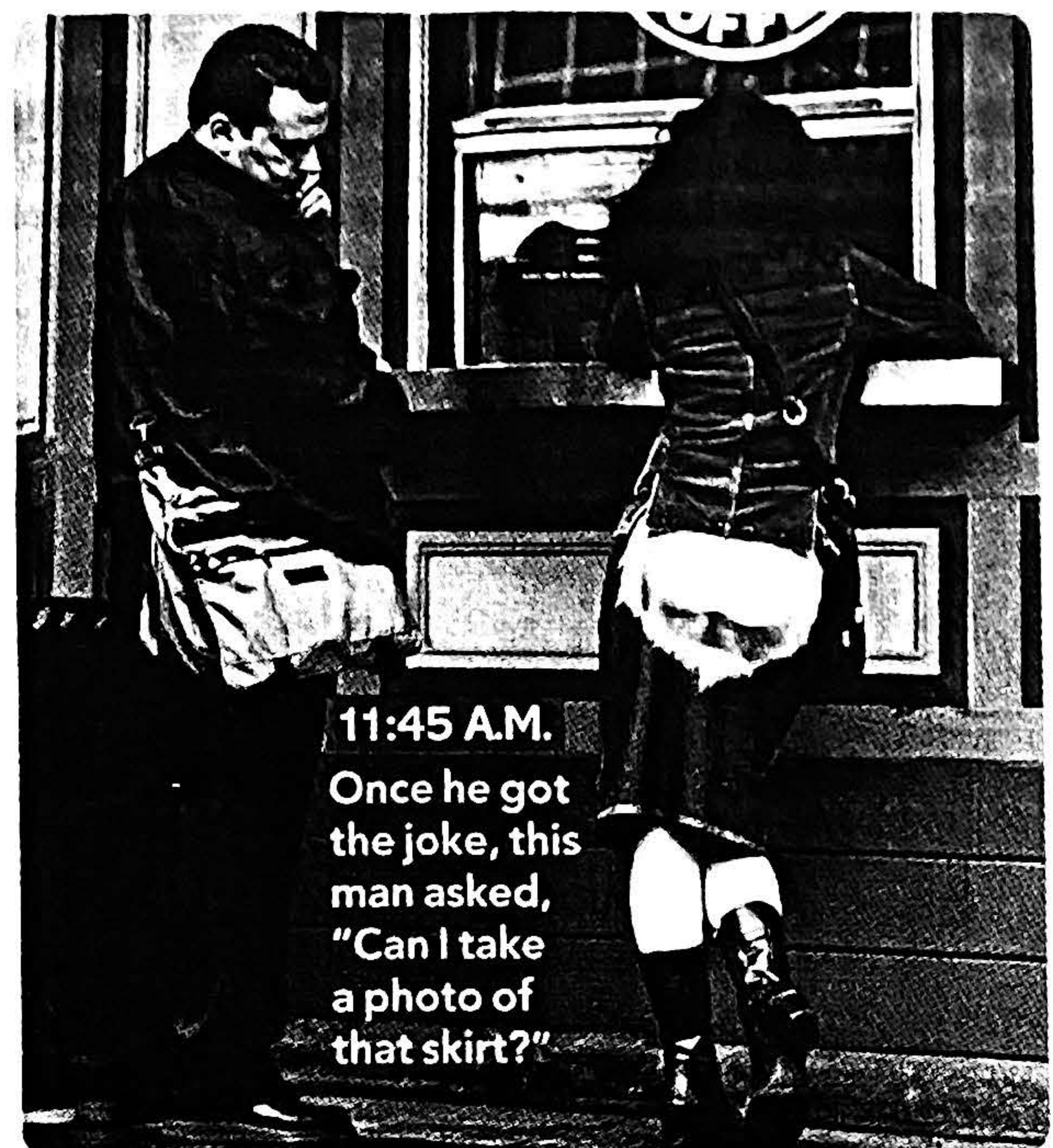


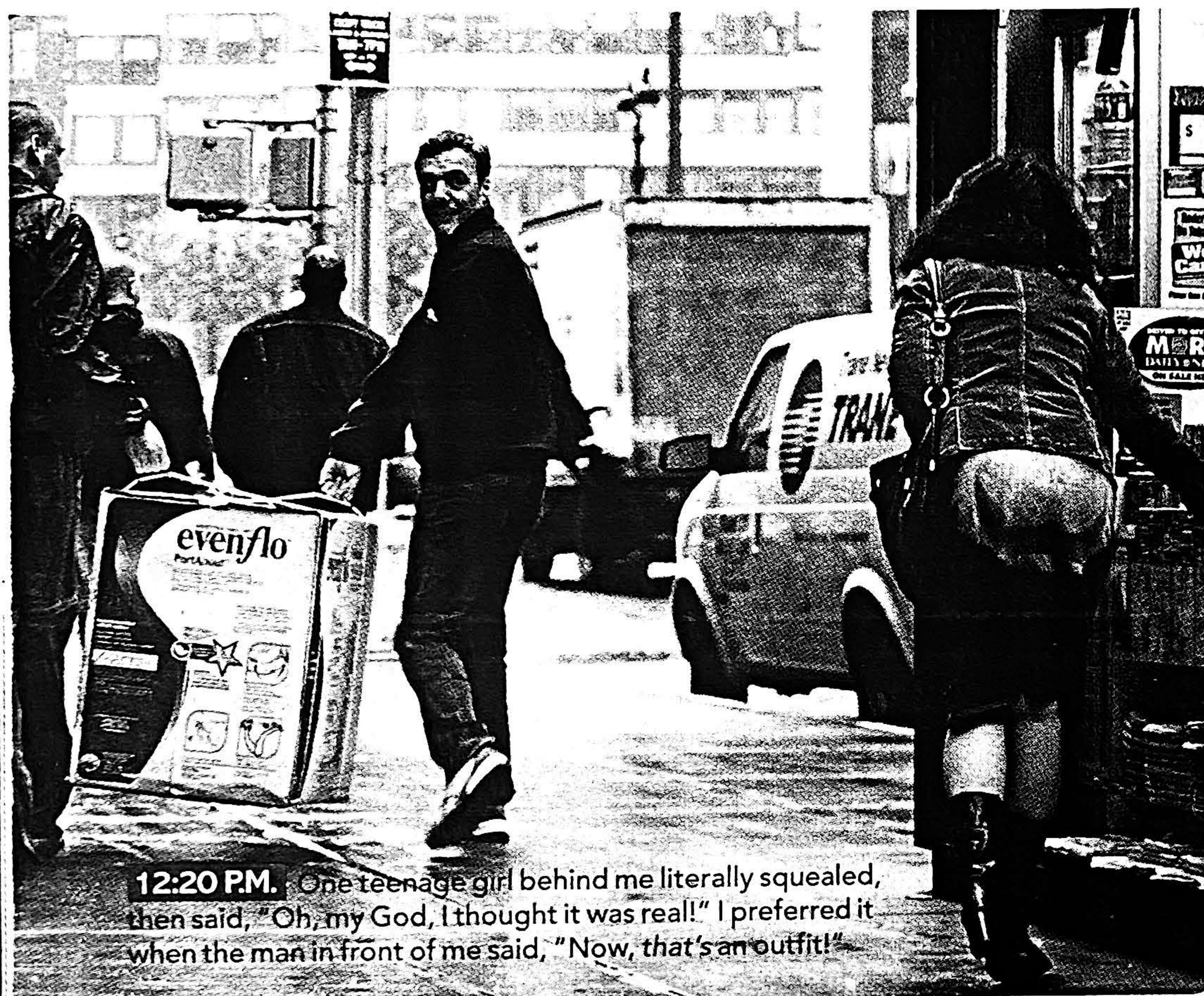
Is that her underwear showing?



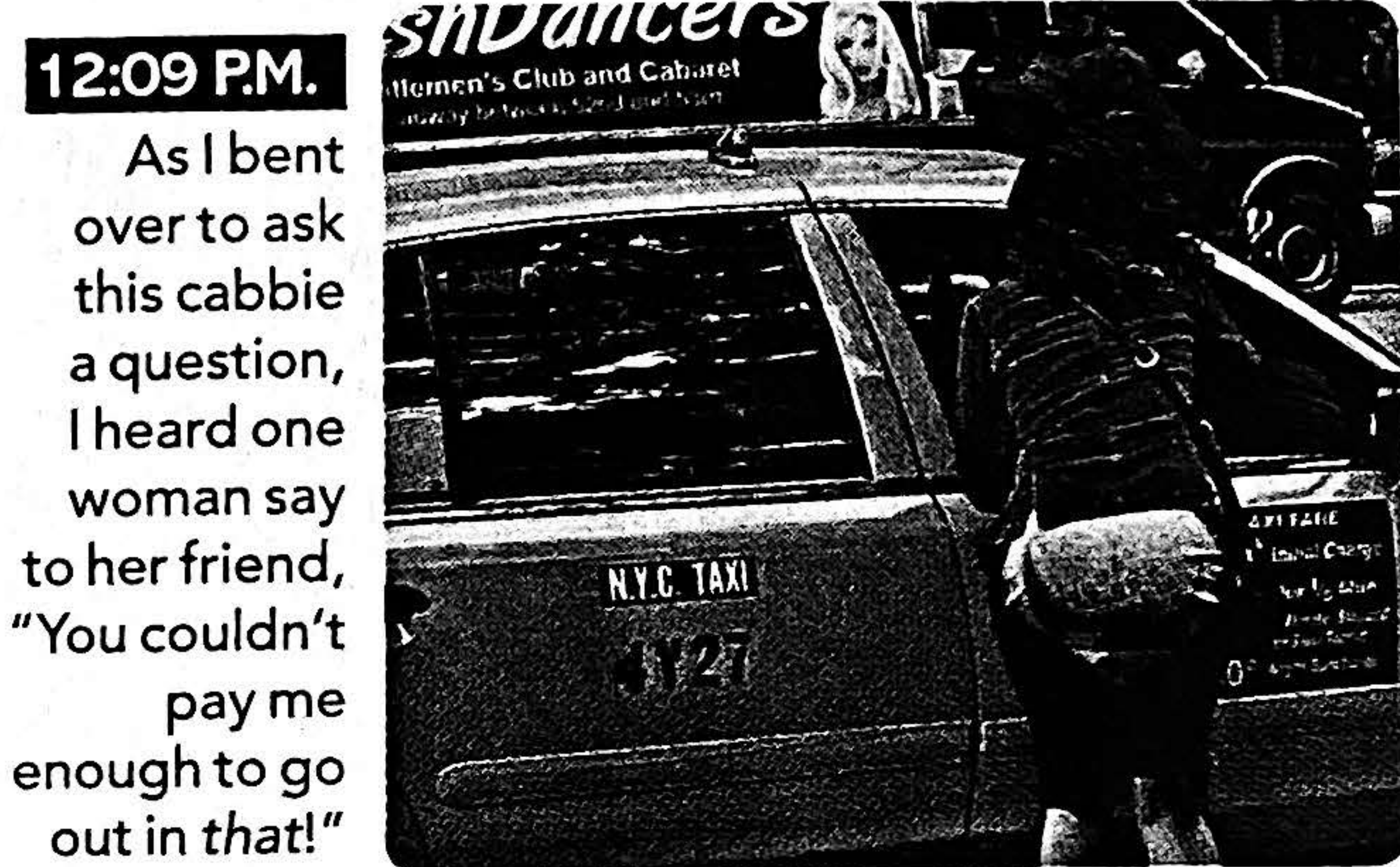
Thankfully, no. Andrea Meyer puts on this made-for-*Glamour* skirt, painted to look see-through, to see what strangers think of it.
